
Multicoloured rovings with the Majacraft diz

1. Selecting the wool.

Coloured wool, either hand carded or machine carded roving, can be used, however the roving has to be broken up into staple lengths (by grasping the roving just further apart than the staple length and pulling - it should slide apart easily)



2. Load the comb.

Load the comb as before but with the two colours side by side. If they are not the same staple length, press them onto the comb so the ends are even on the side that you'll diz from As many colours as you have room for can be loaded.

You can load them one on top of one another too.



2. Diz the fibre.

Hook fibre from both colours through together and diz together Control the amount of each colour in the roving, by the sideways position of the diz.

It will suck more from the batt that is directly in front of the hole.

The two-colour roving is now ready to spin from.
